

Voter's Day: Empowering Citizens, Strengthening Democracy



Innovation for a better tomorrow



Innovation 4th March 2025


The celebrations concluded with a PowerPoint presentation aimed at igniting curiosity and interest in scientific innovation. It featured groundbreaking discoveries, emerging




Echoes of Celebration and Courage



Lohri celebrations: Lohri is a celebration of life, culture, and community, marking the beginning of a new cycle of growth and prosperity.



As a special educator, I have found the following strategies to be effective in building confidence in students with special needs:


- 1. Positive Reinforcement: Focus on praising students for their efforts and accomplishments, rather than criticizing their mistakes.
