- As a part of the Golden Jubilee celebrations, the 5th branch of the school has been opened at Sector 78, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali), in the academic session, 2022-2023. An English-medium and co-educational day school which strives to develop the various facets of a child's personality through quality education. The school offers curriculum that focus on holistic development of individuals by cultivating their unique talent.
- All the branches are managed by the Shivalik Educational Society (Regd.), Chandigarh, a charitable trust. "Victory with Determination" the motto of the school, sets before the scholars an idea of positive thinking, leading to sure success
- Located in a sprawling campus of 10 acres, the digitally smart school has well-endowed Library and Lab facilities like Computer, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Language Labs, and the 3D lab which is a pure delight, taking students into a life- like virtual world, where abstract ideas come to life.
- Atal Tinkering Lab shape our students' ideas through hands on do-it-yourself mode consisting of kits and equipment on – science, electronics, robotics, open source microcontroller boards, sensors and 3D printers and computers including meeting rooms and video conferencing facility.
- Mathematics Lab provides an opportunity for the students to discover mathematics through doing. The activities help them to visualise, manipulate and reason.
- World class sports complex, gymnasium hall with indoor Tennis and Badminton Courts along with the fitness centre, basketball, volleyball courts well-lit with floodlit lights, deco-turf Hockey Ground laid for six –A side Hockey have been provided to offer the best sports facilities.

- The colourful nursery block, E- Blocks for our tiny tots, the herbal garden, the school auditorium and the Open Air Theatre provides an invigorating environment.
- The school's hostel separately for boys and girls well supported with dairy and the vegetable farm provides a comfortable, secure and familial atmosphere.
- It is endorsed with the supply of solar energy, self-sufficient for itself.
- The school buses are also monitored with CCTV and are GPS enabled.

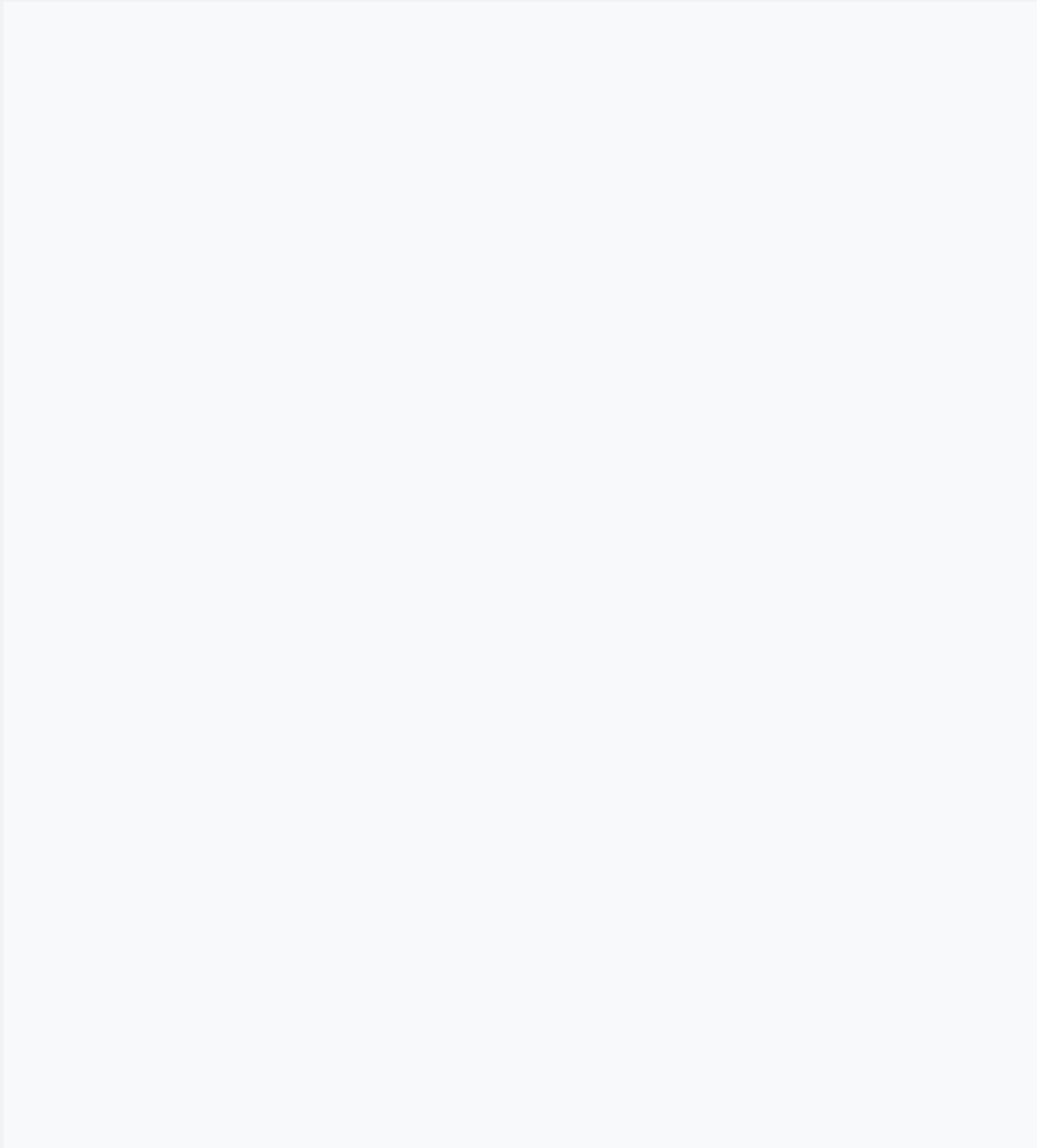

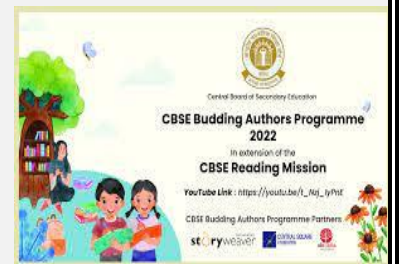
CBSE ESSAY WRITING ACTIVITY

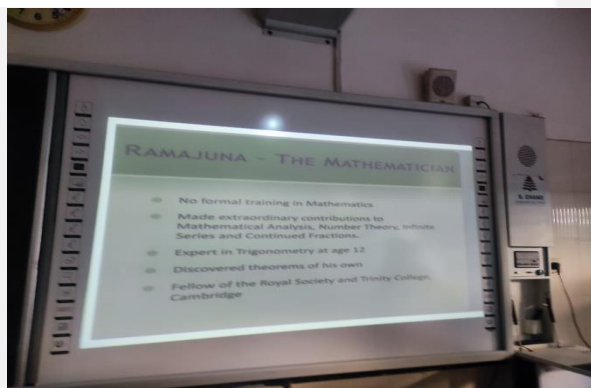
ANNUAL SPORTS MEET

SPECIAL ASSEMBLY ON CHAAR SAHIBZADE

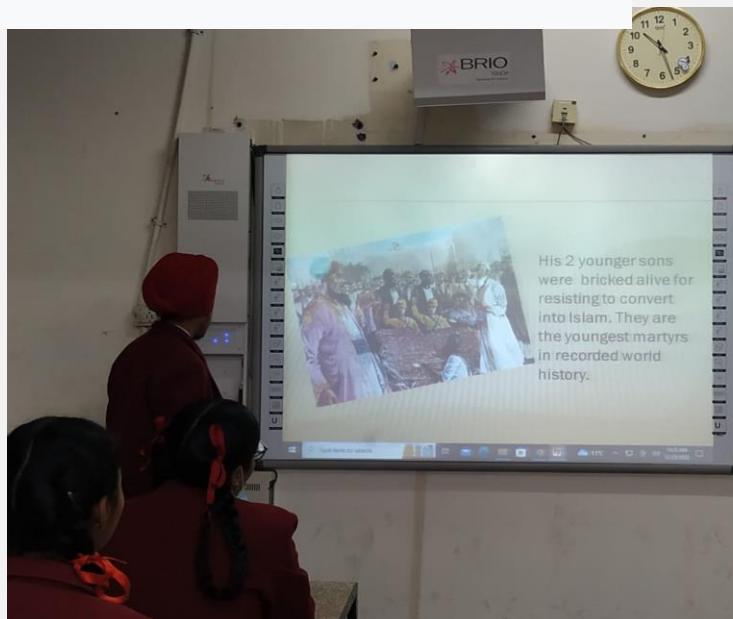
“Strength and courage aren’t always measured in medals and victories. They are measured in the struggle they overcome”

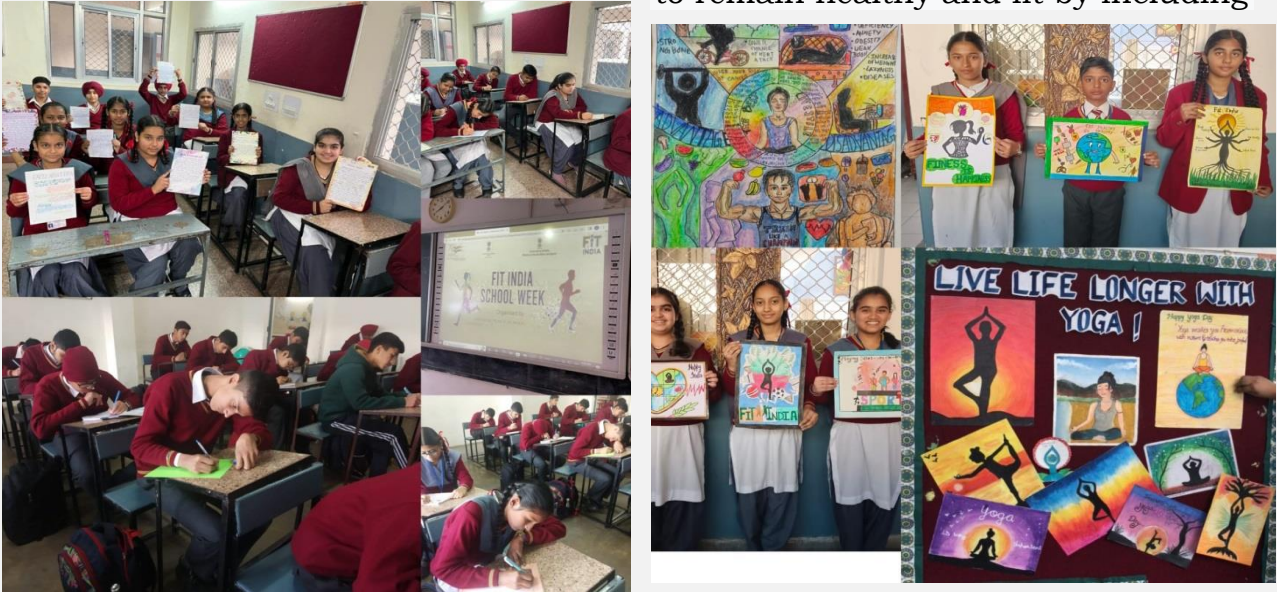
HUBS OF LEARNING

Fit India Movement is a Nation-Wide Movement in India to encourage people to remain healthy and fit by including

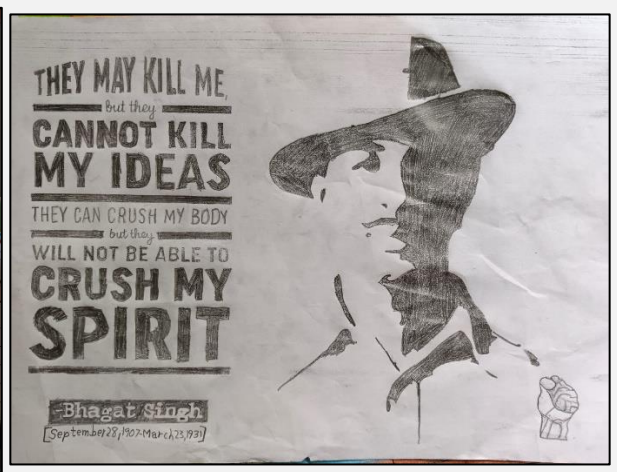
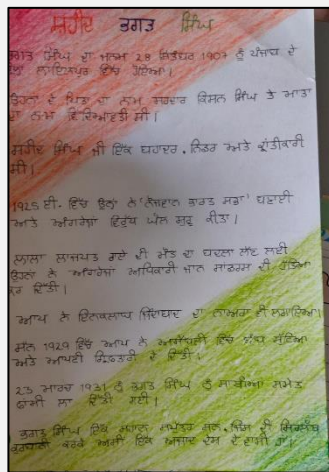
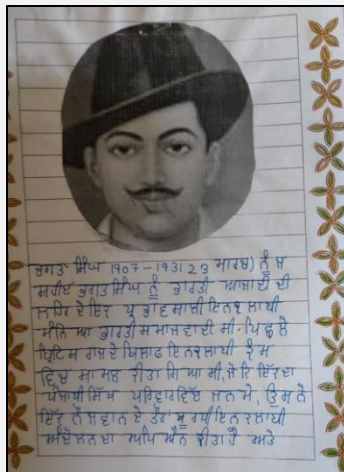

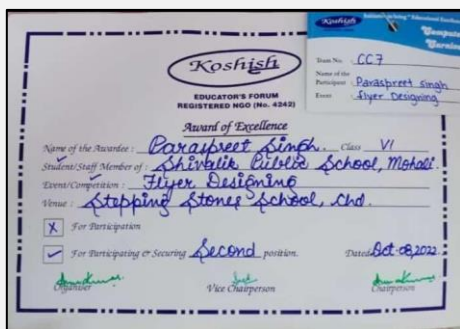
SHAHEED BHAGAT SINGH'S BIRTH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

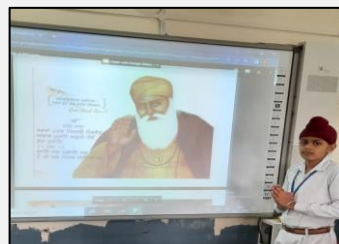

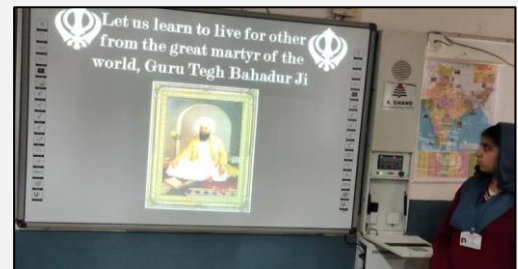
National Constitution Day

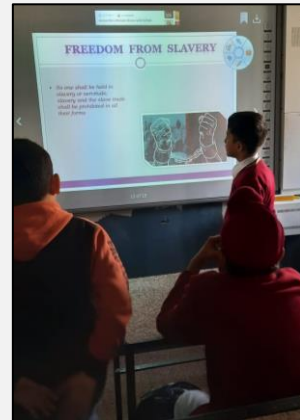
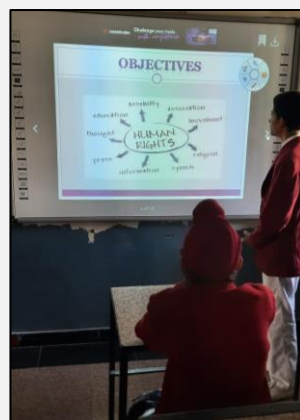
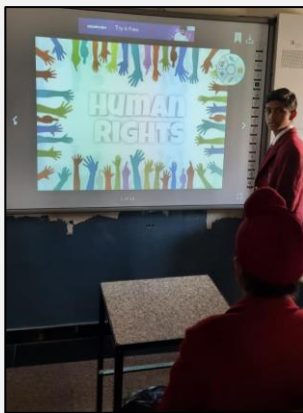
To celebrate Punjab day, an inter-school competition was conducted by Paragon Senior Secondary School Sector 69 Mohali

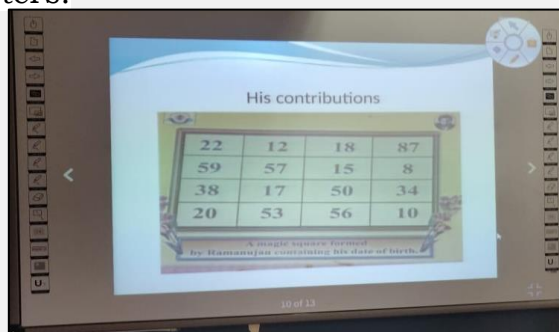
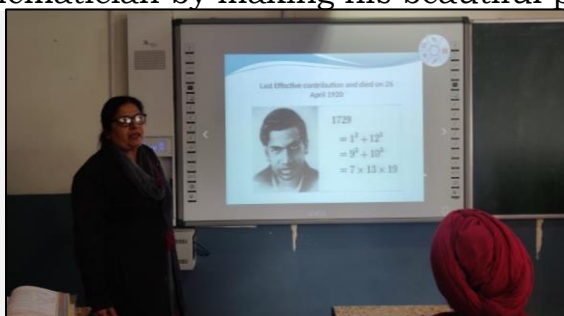
CBSE REGIONAL SCIENCE EXHIBITION

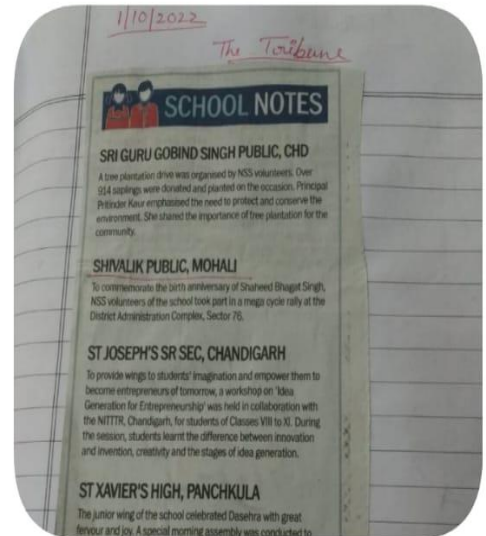
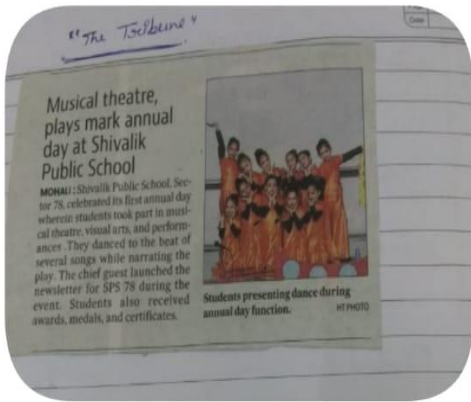


CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

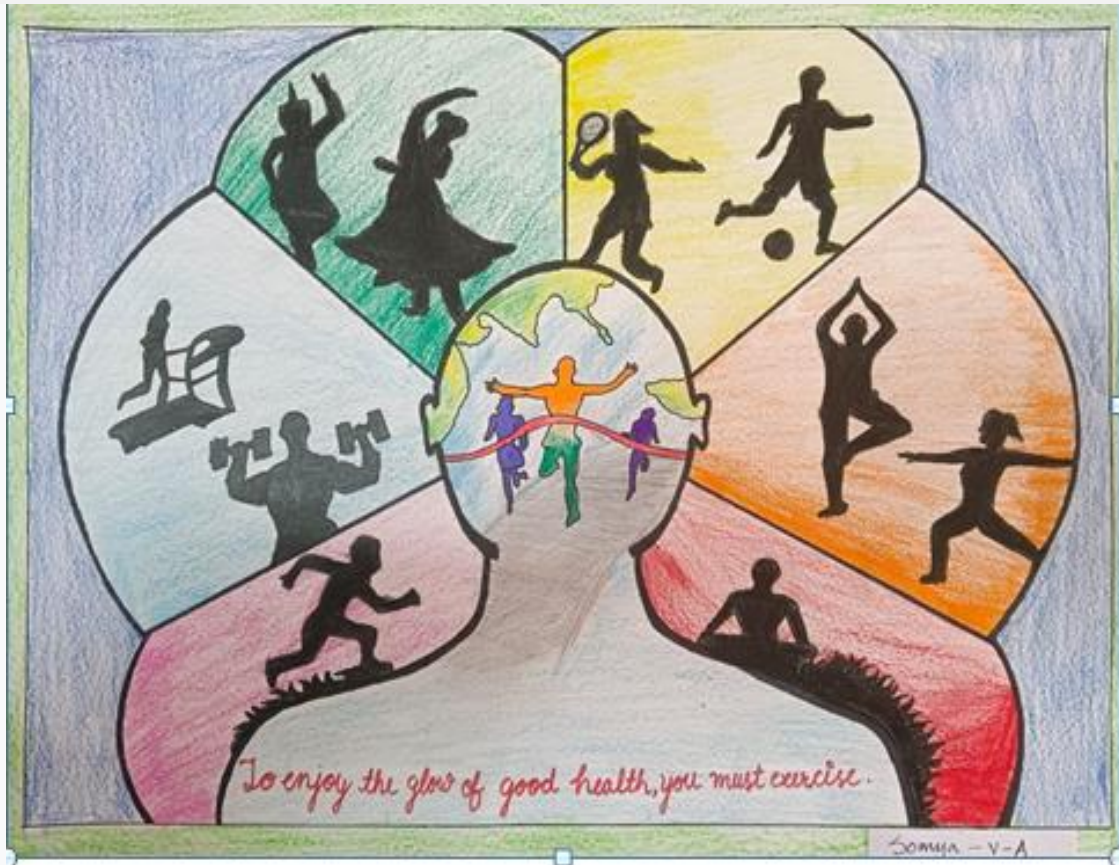
