



By engaging students in hands-on experiences and reflections, they were guided to connect the knowledge gained in the classrooms to real-world situations.








## MASTERFUL MAY

The school organized a bus ride, where children had lots of fun together and they learnt to be more responsible and caring.








#### **Puppet Show**


## JOYFUL JULY










## AMAZING AUGUST




#### **Life Skills Club**




